

HAKI STAIRCASES SWING IN TO ACTION IN IRELAND.



McCroy Access has been appointed as the specialist scaffolding sub-contractor on two prestige hospital projects – Limerick University Hospital and the New National Children's Hospital Dublin.

In both Dublin and Limerick the Haki site staircases were designed to be lifted with a crane to different locations on site to be used to access various floors as works progress around the site of the new hospitals.

Based on a 12-acre site, the new hospital includes over 6,150 rooms, 4 acres of outdoor gardens and external space and 380 individual inpatient rooms.
